INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PUBLICATION OF ARTICLES IN COYUNTURA ECONÓMICA: INVESTIGACIÓN ECONÓMICA Y SOCIAL

The academic journal *Coyuntura Económica: Investigación Económica y Social* of Fedesarrollo is an annual publication whose purpose is to publish articles of high technical quality whose central topics include theoretical and empirical analysis in economic areas, including economic analysis of social issues. Additionally, the journal occasionally includes reports and other intellectual productions.

Articles submitted for consideration by the Editorial Committee must not have been previously published or be simultaneously proposed in other academic journals.

Editorial standards:

- The articles must be sent in Word or in Latex recorded in. rtd and .pdf format. The articles must have a maximum of 50 pages including graphs, tables and annexes.
- 2. Only works written in Spanish or English are accepted.
- 3. The body of the document must include a summary in Spanish and English, of a maximum of 150 words, and at least three keywords in Spanish and English, with their respective JEL classification (https://www.aeaweb.org/iel/guide/iel.php).
- 4. The curriculum vitae of the author(s) must be sent in a separate file.
- 5. The tables, graphs and figures used in the article must be sent in an Excel file.
- 6. The information on all the data used in the work analysis must be clearly and accurately documented.
- 7. References in the body of the document must appear in parentheses with the author's last name and the year of publication, for example (Gómez, 2010) or (Gómez *et ál.*, 2010) if there are more than three authors.
- 8. The bibliographical references at the end of the document must appear in alphabetical order and include only the specific literature about the article. These must be written in the format applied by the American Psychological Association (APA) such as the following example:

Mogg, K., Bradley, B. P., de Bono, J., & Painter, M. (1997). Time course of attentional bias for threat information non-clinical anxiety. Behavioral Research Therapy, 35, 297-303.

Likewise, it is important that the author(s) consider the following guidelines:

- 1. Articles must be sent to covuntura@fedesarrollo.org.co
- 2. All articles must follow the editorial standards attached.
- 3. The articles will be reviewed in the first instance by the Editorial and Scientific Committee and, if considered for publication, will be sent anonymously to specialized referees, who will issue a qualified judgment within three calendar weeks.
- 4. The Editor of the journal will consider the comments made by the anonymous arbitrator in his publication decision, which undertakes to inform the author(s) in a timely manner. If the article is accepted, the comments will be sent to the author(s) who will have three calendar weeks to review the comments and send the article again for review by the Editor.
- 5. The Editor of the journal undertakes to keep the author(s) informed during the different stages of the editorial process.
